Tāmaki Connect Trust is looking for 3 dynamic people who live in the Tāmaki Community to be our community literacy connectors for our Tāmaki Ako Hub. Tāmaki Ako Hub is a unique and innovative model for the delivery of adult literacy services in Tāmaki. This is a new project, providing free adult literacy services to people in Glen Innes, Pt England and Panmure.

This paid role will involve:

- sharing literacy opportunities with the community by encouraging people to actively participate in literacy learning.
- sharing community insights & ascertaining what the community **need** in terms of literacy learning, as this will be central to us providing a responsive service.

This role would ideally suit someone who already has established relationships within the Tāmaki Community. He/she needs to be self-motivated and confident in seeking out individuals and groups of people in the Tāmaki Community who would benefit from learning literacy.

This trust based flexible role means there are high levels of independence to meet outcomes. It could be a great fit for someone who likes the autonomy of working their own hours.

The successful candidate will need to have:

- Great interpersonal skills
- Excellent communication skills
- An empathy for people with low confidence in basic and day to day literacy
- A willingness to learn and collaborate
- Self driven with a strong interest and integrity around this vision of improving literacy in our Tāmaki Community
- Current NZ Drivers Licence
